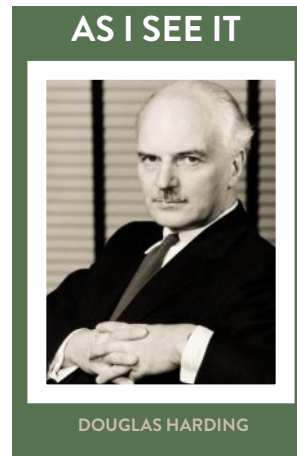


An Unconventional Portrait Of Yourself
